- 7. Processes and manages Dual Enrollment for the Middle College, Sumner and Robertson County students.
- **8.** Supervises and evaluates faculty and support staff of assigned programs.
- **9.** Approves faculty and support staff leave and coordinates coverage.
- 10. Participates in student services office decision-making, planning, and office policies and procedures.
- 11. Counsels and assists students as needed.
- 12. Develops and leads all programs in Portland and Springfield.
- 13. Acts as liaison between instructors, students, and employees.
- 14. Evaluates and recommend changes with the program offerings.
- 15. Communicates with students regarding financial aid and related matters.
- **16.** Coordinates contract classes and assist instructors as needed.
- 17. Develops, evaluate, and monitor program curriculum.
- 18. Assists in program certifications.
- 19. Assists with graduation activities.
- 20. Coordinates and investigates student complaints.
- 21. Assists with SkillsUSA.
- 22. Performs other duties as assigned.
