Siloam Health is a faith-based nonprofit health center providing affordable, whole-person health care for the uninsured. We are looking for an energetic and compassionate nurse with current LPN licensure and CPR certification who has a passion for Christian ministry to multi-ethnic persons with limited access to healthcare.

Job Purpose

The staff nurse at Siloam collaborates with the larger team to provide patient care through intake, basic triage, onsite diagnostics and treatments, patient education and occasional home visits. Everything is done in the context of whole-person care with a team model.

Primary Duties & Responsibilities

- Provides nursing support directly for one specific med/peds physician but also for the entire team of providers along with the other nurses.
- Provides basic triage on a rotating basis.
- Performs in-office procedures as needed including HbA1c, blood glucose, strep screen, U/A, pregnancy test, EKGs and audiometry.
- Provides PO, IM and nebulized medications as needed. Provides IV access on occasion.
- Performs phlebotomy for in-office laboratory on a rotating basis.
- Collaborates with other members of the team by making phone calls on behalf of the provider to the patient, pharmacy or another physician's office.
- Provides patient education as directed by provider.
- Provides care management of the patients for their designated provider.
- Delivers care in the manner that preserves patient autonomy, dignity and rights.
