HOW TO APPLY TO THE PRACTICAL NURSE PROGRAM

- 1. You must take the Compass Assessment and pass the test.
- 2. Once you have passed the test, you will receive your application and packet.
- 3. The deadline date to have the packet complete is Friday, October 28, 2016.
- **4.** Once you have completed and returned the application packet, you will receive notification letter to attend a **mandatory** information session.

TCAT NASHVILLE COMPASS ASSESSMENT TEST INFORMATION

All applicants are required to take the Compass test. Registration for the COMPASS is available on-line only @ www.registerblast.com/ttc/exam The Compass test fee is \$18.00, payable on-line only.

The Compass Assessment Test consists of Math Skills and Reading Comprehension Skills. Minimum passing scores are 50 in Pre-Algebra and 80 in Reading Comprehension. Passing the test does not guarantee admission into the nursing program. ACT Scores of a 19 or above in all subject matters will be accepted in lieu of the Compass Assessment Test. The ACT scores are valid only if taken within the last 2 years from the date of applying.

Program Length

The length of the program is 12 months (1296 hours). Class meets Monday through Friday, 7:45 a.m. to 2:15 p.m. the first trimester. Second and third trimester, class will be two days a week from 7:45 a.m. to 2:15 p.m. and clinical will be three days a week from 6:30 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. (Class and clinical dates and times are subject to change based on clinical space availability).
